

Cancer Care, Orthopedics and Children's Services

MetroHealth's team of oncologists, oncology nurses and other medical professionals emphasize early detection and use their clinical expertise and highly specialized technology to help patients overcome their disease. Patients have access to some of the most innovative treatment options in Northeast Ohio, including localized radiation therapy, chemotherapy and minimally invasive surgery.

The orthopedics team includes Cleveland's best orthopedic surgeons, physical medicine and rehabilitation physicians or physiatrists, plastic surgeons, occupational therapists or hand therapists and physical therapists. As a Level I Adult Trauma Center and a Level II Pediatric Trauma Center, MetroHealth providers are adept at repairing damage from serious trauma.

MetroHealth Medical Center has been able to provide a neighborhood-based maternal/child health program since 1965. The Child and Family Health Services Program provides direct clinical services, a variety of community outreach and health education services and community health assessment and planning activities.

Weight Loss Program

There is no one-size-fits-all approach to weight loss. That's why MetroHealth offers both bariatric surgery and nonsurgical options to achieve a healthy weight for life. Their multidisciplinary team includes surgeons, physicians, advanced practice providers, nurses, behavioral medicine specialists, dietitians and others who are specially trained in obesity management.

MetroHealth's Weight Loss Surgery and Weight Management Program recently received a distinguished level of re-certification for three years from the Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery Accreditation and Quality Improvement Program (MBSAQIP) as a Comprehensive Center with Obesity Medicine Qualifications.

Benefits Overview

CLE-Care gives employers and employees access to complete benefits, excellent care and cost control measures to help manage premiums and out-of-pocket costs. As a non-gatekeeper HMO, it doesn't require members to coordinate care through a primary care physician, so they can access specialists directly and save money. However, it is requested that members select a primary care MetroHealth physician as regular health screenings can lead to better health outcomes and reduced costs.

Pharmacy Benefits

Through CLE-Care, your employees can conveniently receive the prescriptions they need in a number of ways. Employees have access to MetroHealth's 11 pharmacy locations to fill their medications. If your employees take medications regularly, they can also opt in for their MetroHealth prescription refills to be filled through a 90-day mail order and delivered directly to their residence. For added convenience, MetroHealth physicians can electronically submit scripts to fill name brand, generic and specialty medications.

If alternative pharmacy benefits are needed, the Express Scripts network is also included in your benefit plan.

Pharmacy Value Program

MetroHealth's Pharmacy Value Program helps members save on prescription and over- the-counter medicines.

Over-the-counter (OTC) medications and routine immunizations are also available at their pharmacies. If members are using another pharmacy, prescriptions can be transferred at no additional cost.

Coordination of Care

Through clinical integration and patient-centered practices, CLE-Care HMO[®] providers coordinate patient care more effectively and efficiently through all stages of life, ensuring appropriate healthcare is administered over time. To further coordinate your care, all CLE-Care providers keep electronic medical records through MyChart, which is easily accessible for patients through the MyChart mobile application or website. This ensures that no matter what provider you visit in the CLE-Care network, all your medical information and test results will be housed in the same location.

Out-of-network Restrictions

This plan only covers out-of-network benefits for medical emergencies. Emergencies are always covered at any hospital regardless of network status. The member is responsible for the costs of non-emergency care received out of network.



Virtual Visits

Not every medical visit needs to take place in person. For some health care needs, a virtual visit can be a fast, easy and convenient option.

A virtual visit—sometimes referred to as a telehealth visit—lets you meet with your health care provider by video or phone. This allows you to get the care you need, when you need it.

Some benefits of a virtual visit:

- Meet with your provider without leaving home.
- No need to travel or deal with parking.
- Avoid coming into contact with other patients who may be sick.



Cost-effective Option

Since this plan is exclusive to MetroHealth providers and hospitals and other CLE-Care contracted providers, the health system is able to offer discounted reimbursement rates to Medical Mutual. This agreed-upon payment means lower premiums than traditional and PPO health insurance plans. In addition to lower premiums, deductibles are replaced with co-pays, which are typically low, minimizing the out-of-pocket expenses and making this type of plan affordable for both employers and employees.



Tools and Resources

My Health Plan – Administered through Medical Mutual

Through My Health Plan, the secure Wellness Portal on Medical Mutual's member website and application, employees can check their benefits, view claims and deductible information, as well as access their spending accounts. Additionally, they can learn about a variety of health and wellness topics, enroll in your health plan's wellness or disease management program (if applicable) and receive reminders about needed care. Interactive tools are also available to help employees set and achieve wellness goals, such as eating healthier, managing stress and quitting tobacco.

MyChart – Administered through MetroHealth

Through MyChart, employees stay up-to-date on their care routines chosen by their MetroHealth providers through appointment scheduling and prescription refill options. They also have the ability to view their test results, email their doctors, view health summaries and sign up for health reminders. Since all MetroHealth providers coordinate care using MyChart, employee's health information will always be current, no matter which doctor they see within the network.
